HEALTH EFFECTS

Acute

Swallowed: May result in nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea

Eye: Mild irritant

Skin: Mild irritant

Inhaled: Does not present an inhalation problem

First Aid If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre, Ph: 13 11 26.

Swallowed: Rinse mouth with water. Give large quantities of water or bland fluids to drink. Seek medical attention.

Eye: Immediately flush eye with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes

Skin: Wash skin with soap and water. Remove all contaminated clothing

Advice to Doctor Treat symptomatically

Exposure Standards: LD50 (oral, rat) approx. 250-350 mg/kg. LD50 (oral, mouse) approx. 500-700 mg/kg.

Personal Protection: Avoid eye contact. Wear eye protection (face visor or goggles) if accidental eye contact can occur. Wear gloves. Observe good personal hygiene.

Flammability: Non flammable. Keep well away from heat and keep container closed when not in use.

Storage: No special storage requirements. Store below 30°C. Store in original container tightly closed. Store away from foodstuffs. Protect from light.

Transport: Animol is not classified as a Dangerous Good for the purpose of road or rail transport.

Spills: Slippery when split. For small spills, wipe, then wash area to drain with excess water. For large spills, contain using absorbent material. Collect and seal in properly labelled containers for disposal. Wash area to drain with excess water.

Disposal: Refer to the relevant State Land Waste Management Authority

Fire/Explosion Hazard: The product is non flammable. Use alcohol foam, CO₂, dry powder, water or BCF fire extinguishers. Use water to keep fire exposed containers cool. May emit toxic fumes when heated to decomposition.
